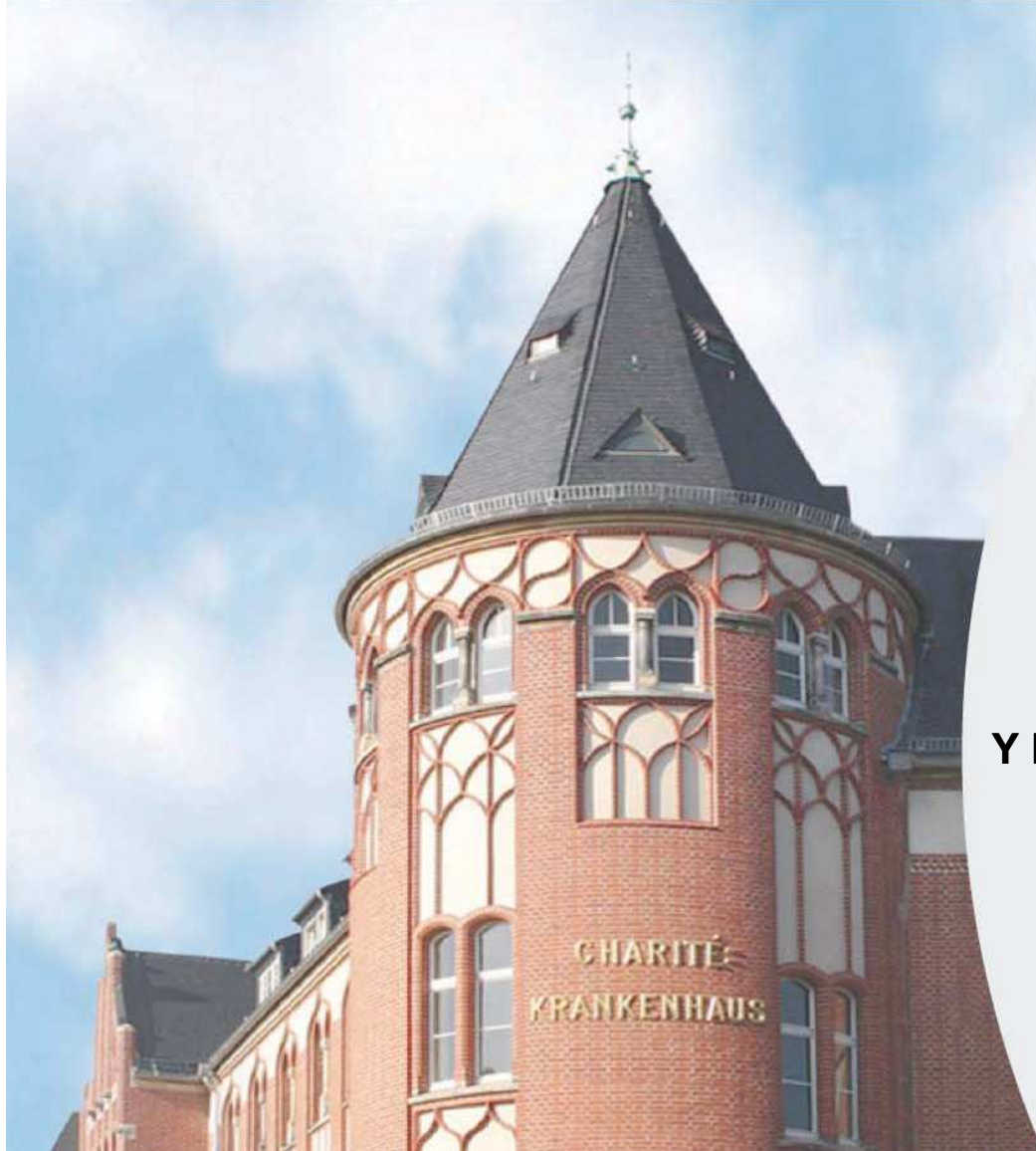

 - ▶ Truthfulness

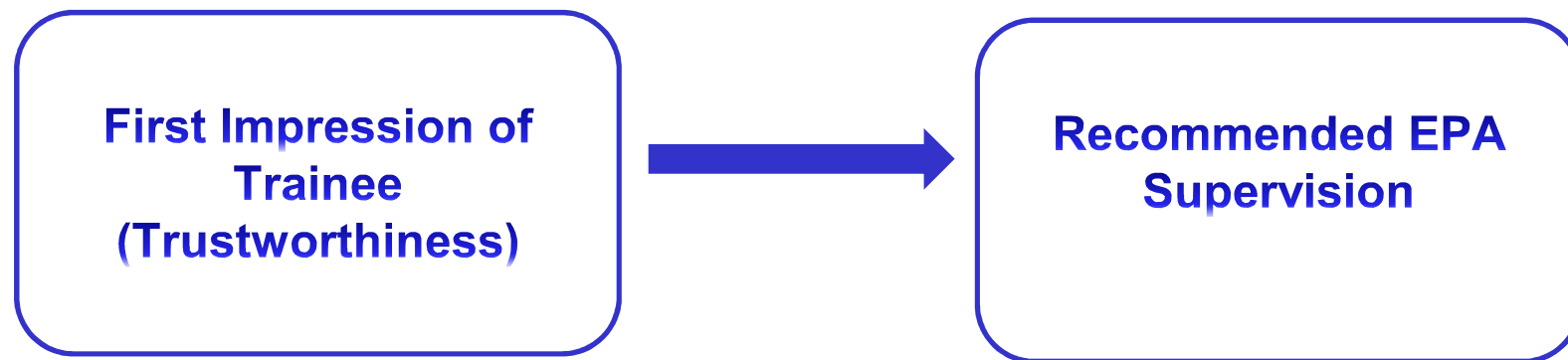
Trustworthiness
